The oil and gas industry can experience erratic demand each year, bringing significant growth and decline in short periods of time.

The 2020 U.S. Energy & Employment Report found that employers in the oil and natural gas sector added more than 18,000 jobs in 2019, contributing more new jobs to the U.S. economy than any other fuel sector. However, the unpredictable nature of the industry has continued to hold true in 2020: according to the U.S. Energy Information Administration, the COVID-19 pandemic has caused changes in energy demand and supply patterns, and oil production has fallen in 2020, but could rise later in 2021.

And when demand increases, companies have to send their employees to project locations with little notice, causing an equally unpredictable need for workforce lodging.

The challenges of workforce travel for the oil and gas industry


